Messy play was a big hit too, with shaving foam shaped like a snowman and a hungry penguin to feed with the correct number of pompoms.

Alongside our winter activities, the children enjoyed getting creative with playdough and were especially excited about our newly refreshed home corner, complete with a brand-new kitchen setup. It quickly became a favourite space for role-play and imaginative cooking.

CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY

HOME LEARNING IDEAS

- 1. Make a Winter Sensory Bottle Fill an empty plastic bottle with water, a little glitter, and some small items (buttons, sequins, beads). Children can shake it and watch the "snow" swirl.
- Build a Cosy Reading Den Use blankets, cushions, or a bed sheet to create a small reading nook. Add torches or fairy lights and enjoy winter or Christmas stories together.
- 3. Salt Dough Decorations Mix 1 cup flour, ½ cup salt, and ½ cup water to make salt dough. Cut out shapes with cookie cutters, bake on a low heat, and paint once cool.
