

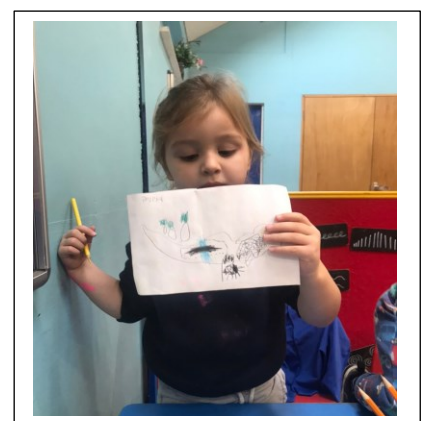
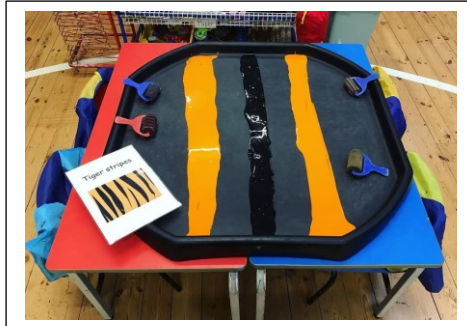
Friday 24th January 2025

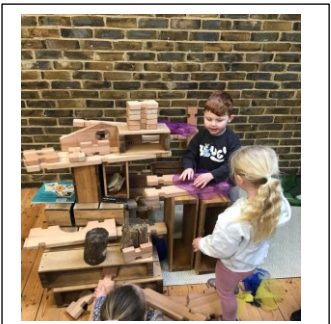
