This week is World Nursery Rhyme Week, so we have enjoyed some of our favourite rhymes with lots of fun activities linked to these. Nursery rhymes support language and communication skills by introducing new vocabulary and helping children recognise the sounds in words. Fine and gross motor skills are used as children join in with actions whilst singing and some rhymes teach basic maths concepts. Children also love to sing about colourful characters doing funny things, for example, cows jumping over moons and little men zooming off into space. This helps children to have a vivid imagination and develop humour which is a lovely thing, for us as adults, to share with them.

On Monday we had a poppy theme and some of the children watched the very touching CBeebies video which gives a gentle introduction to Remembrance Day. We found that the children were able to share their thoughts and talk about their own understanding of 'poppy day'. We worked on a group art project of a beautiful poppy field which you may have seen displayed outside. On Wednesday we had a very energetic basketball session with Little All Sports.

Inhalers and prescribed medication.


