We have had a busy week with our taster session of Baby Ballet and the return of our multi sports class run by Lisa at Little All Sports. Wet Weather Gear

We have found that avoiding a long wait in the line where emotions can build and a calmer entry into nursery can really help the children settle and get on with the important task of having lots of fun.

These reports help us to understand your child's development and to plan our curriculum so that we can meet their needs and help them to progress and thrive.
