This week our learning and play has had a crocodile theme, based on the story, The Crocodile Who Didn't Like Water. We have listened to the story many times and the children are familiar with the story sequence, characters and vocabulary. The children love that the little crocodile is in fact a dragon and we have lots of wonderful conversations about the differences between the two.

The children have designed their own crocodile and dragon eggs, used toothpaste and toothbrushes to clean the crocodile teeth, made playdough eggs and practiced their mark making as they filled in speech bubbles on the dragon writing table.

On Wednesday we had a gym session with Lisa from Little All Sports. The children used the trampette and worked on balance skills.


