OUTDOOR LEARNING

Our light and dark theme continued outdoors, exploring sensory play in sand and mud, creating colourful chalk patterns and practising letter S and star mark making. The children built star-shaped obstacle courses using planks, hoops and tyres, compared the sizes of animals and stars, and worked together in fun challenges like blindfold games and group hunts. They also made pine cone bird feeders, spun colour wheels, and created sparkly S for Star wands. A fun and active week of outdoor discovery!

HOME LEARNING IDEAS

- Starry Story: Make up a short story about a star, moon, or nocturnal animal and draw pictures to go with it.
- 2. Nature Light Hunt: Collect shiny or reflective objects on a walk and talk about what makes them sparkle.
- 3. Shadow Play: Use a torch to make animal or star shapes on the wall.
- 4. Night & Day Sorting: Sort pictures or toys into "day" and "night" groups.
- 5. Starry Snack: Create a snack with starshaped fruit, cheese, or biscuits and count them together.
